Job Type

- In-Office, Part-time – 7 hours/week
- Day and hours to be determined; i.e. 1 full day either Wednesdays or Thursdays 9:30 AM to 5:30 PM; or 2 half-days on Wednesdays and Thursdays
- Opportunity for additional hours' depending on programming needs
- Occasional evenings as required by activities/programming
- Telework as determined by the Executive Director. If employees are required to work from home because of public health mandates, staff are required to be available for emails, calls and meetings during regular business hours providing effective and prompt communication while completing all job responsibilities.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Create programming for individual and group needs.
- Design, prepare, and lead music therapy sessions both in-person and virtually.
- Assess the therapeutic needs of participants.
- Observe individual participants and participation in group dynamics. Flag any concerns and communicate these to an interdisciplinary team. Strategize interventions and reassess and adjust participation level as needed.
- Fulfil any administrative duties related to the position including completing statistics, updating client files, writing reports, participating in meetings etc.,
- Other duties as assigned
